<p>Reflection on the year so far- what have we achieved? What impact have we had?</p>	<p>The children talked about all the work that went into the Willow Brook Parking Policy earlier in the year. The children felt that parking had improved and therefore safety had improved but that there is still a need for reminders as the situation is not yet perfect: people still occasionally park on the curb, on the yellow lines and in the bus stop. The children also discussed that they too have a responsibility to cross safely in order to ensure safety and felt this was important to discuss. The children in year five and six met to analyse the child anti-bullying posters and felt the messages were accurate and the only suggestions for change were minor, single word amendments so these stayed the same and will be amended next academic year 2018/2019. The children spent a great deal of time sharing their learning on their project on plastics, the environment and litter. They discussed how they had been worried about the use of disposable plastic cups at lunchtime and how these have now been replaced with reusable ones. The children also discussed how they had created class pledges in Class Council to pledge to bring in their own water bottles and take them into the dining hall rather than use a disposable cup for ease.
