Expectations of behaviour and conduct at playtimes to ensure a happy and harmonious time	The children were shown the comic strip created at the end of last academic year by the Creative Department of the previous School Council. Each section of the strip was explained and discussed to check that all children understood and agreed with the comic strip, which they did. Any other suggestions for a harmonious playtime	<p>I asked the children to consider anything else we could agree to do in addition to the expectations outlined on the comic strip, to ensure play times are harmonious. These are the suggestions they came up with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No pulling/pushing • Don't pick children up • Use kind words only • Take care when rushing/running around • Tell people to stop if they are being mean/annoying (I reiterated that they would not get in trouble for this) but don't retaliate with mean words or anything physical (we agreed that this response would require a sanction!) • No rough play or play fighting • Let people choose who they play with • Share ideas and work together when playing games • Respect the equipment 	School Council to work on wet play time expectations - clarify these as we have focussed on outdoor playtime today
