Feedback the ideas from Class Council and share ideas from the latest School Council Meeting	<p>The School Councillors shared the responses from the Class Council surveys and told the children of the common responses and themes that appeared. They shared their idea of writing a letter to parents/carers to ask for donations for board games and jigsaws as this was something every class said they wanted more of. Everyone agreed this was a good idea so the letter will go ahead.</p> <p>I shared the idea of School Councillors having a role during wet breaks of helping to ensure harmonious playtimes through setting out the wet play toys and equipment and reporting any issues to the MDSAs. We shared the idea of children staying in their own classroom during wet lunch times except for year six (due to their class location) who will be split (with friends) between all the classrooms. If this does not work due to the number of MDSAs available then children will select a classroom and stay there for the duration of the playtime and MDSAs will ask children to move to another room if there are too many in one room.</p> <p>School Council shared their idea to have a meeting with the MDSAs to share all of their ideas and to ask if they will work logistically with the number of MDSAs we have etc. I will arrange this.</p>	<p>School Council to compose a letter to parents requesting donations of good quality board games and jigsaws that are no longer used at home.
