

1. *The Rainbow Fish* and other stories

Once you have read the story once, read it again and talk about the story topics

Talk about the story with your child. You might use these questions to help discuss it:

What is the story about?

Where is the story set?

Why is the Rainbow Fish called the Rainbow fish?

Why doesn't anyone like the Rainbow Fish?

Who does the Rainbow Fish talk to for advice?

Where does the Rainbow Fish go?

What do all the fish want from the Rainbow Fish?

What happens in the end?

How does the Rainbow Fish feel in the end?

Angry


Happy

The Rainbow Fish shared his scales left and right. The more he gave away the more delighted he became.


"Give away my scales, my beautiful shiny scales? Never!"

Can you label the Rainbow fish below? Think about the different parts of the fish along with what it looks like. Use my arrows to start you off. There may be more labels you can think of.




4. Sentence writing: The Rainbow Fish


11. Talking about Feelings

15. Create a rock pool




Or you could even find a large container and fill it with pebbles and seaweed (kale) and shells, you never know a creature may decide to live here one day.




