When adding *-ing* to a root word it means that the verb is happening in the present tense.

If the root word ends in a vowel or a double constant you just need to add *-ing* to the end.

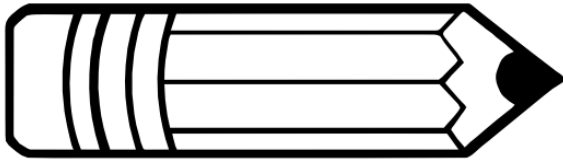
