3. Fabian takes half an hour to do his homework. He starts at quarter past 3. What time does he finish?

4. Luke goes to bed at 8 o'clock in the evening and wakes up at 4 o'clock in the morning. How long does he sleep?



5. Mr Jones goes to school at half past seven. He comes home at quarter past six. How many hours does he spend at school?

6. I leave home at half past 10. It takes me 25 minutes to drive to ASDA. I really don't enjoy myself in ASDA. But what time did I arrive?


9. A bowling game takes 10 minutes for each person playing. If 5 people play, how long does it take? If they start at 4:20 what time will they finish?

11. A duck race is due to start at 1:40, but there is a delay of 55 minutes due to escaped ducks. What time does the race start? The winning duck completes the race in 25 minutes. What time does she finish?
