

Literacy: Diary Writing

Friday

Learning Objective: To use their phonics knowledge to write short sentences in a meaningful context.

Task: To write a simple diary entry to explain something that you have enjoyed this week. Children should be reminded to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. They should also be encouraged to say their sentence out loud and then sound out each word, writing down all of the sounds that they can hear. Spelling does not have to be accurate but should be phonically plausible. If your child needs a little more help, you could sound out the sentence together, recording it for them to copy.

The phonics UK app <https://apps.apple.com/gb/app/phonics-uk/id621360987> is a great interactive sound map to help your child find the letters or sounds that they need for writing. Once you have done your writing, there is also space at the bottom to draw a lovely picture.
