

City, town and village



This is Nottingham. It is a **City** in England with a population of around 800,000 people. Cities are large areas where lots of people live. In a city you will find; houses, big shops, factories, markets, offices, churches and lots of schools. They have good transport links and will often have train stations and bus stations. They have different leisure facilities such as ice rinks, bowling alleys, swimming pools and arenas for shows.

This is West Bridgford. It is a **Town** in Nottingham. A town is not as big as a city. Around 50,000 people live here. Towns often have similar buildings as cities. You will find; houses, larger shops, markets, churches and usually more than one school. They also have leisure facilities like swimming pools. Many towns have parks and playgrounds where people can play.



This is Plumtree. A village in Nottingham. It has a population of around 300 people. Villages and hamlets are the smallest areas to live. Villages contain; houses, schools, farms, fields, small shops and churches. Houses tend to have lots of space around them with big gardens.
