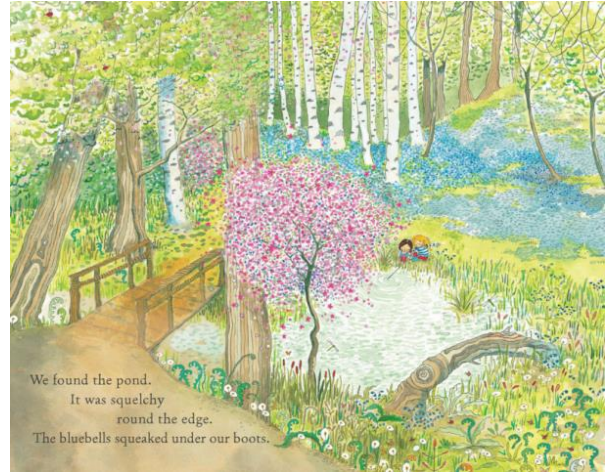

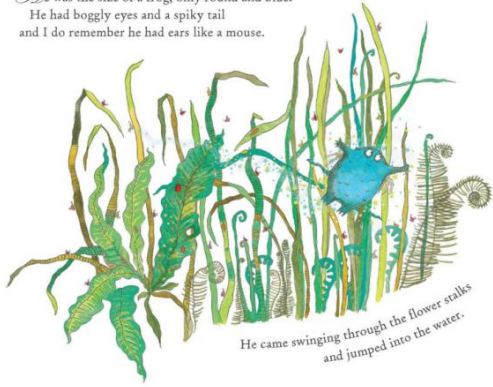
What was the place like where they found Bog Baby?



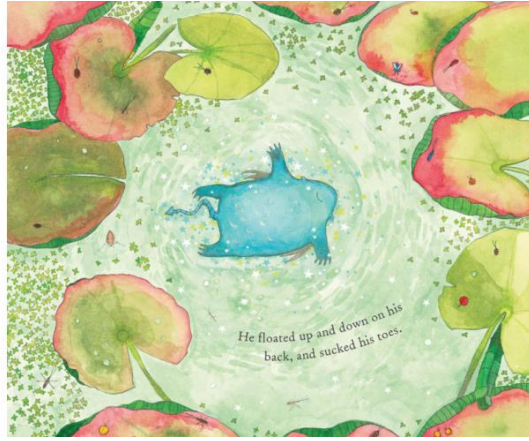
What does Bog Baby look like?
