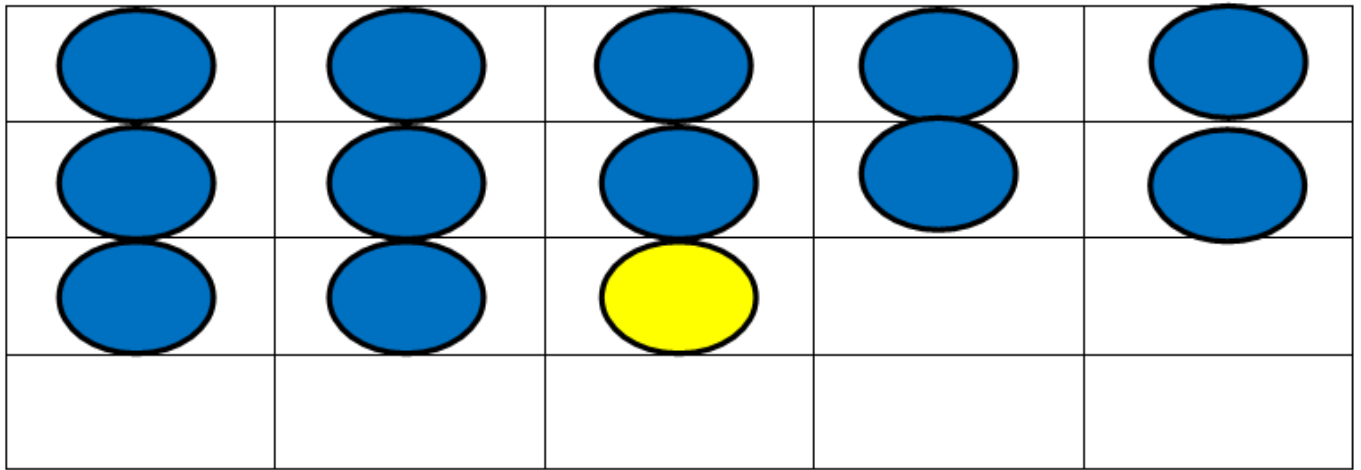

I can recognise related facts.

Related facts is when you notice a pattern between a group of numbers. For example-

If you know $12+1=13$, then you can also understand that $13-1=12$. This helps you when you think about $13-12=1$ and $1+12=13$. The numbers are all related in almost a pattern.



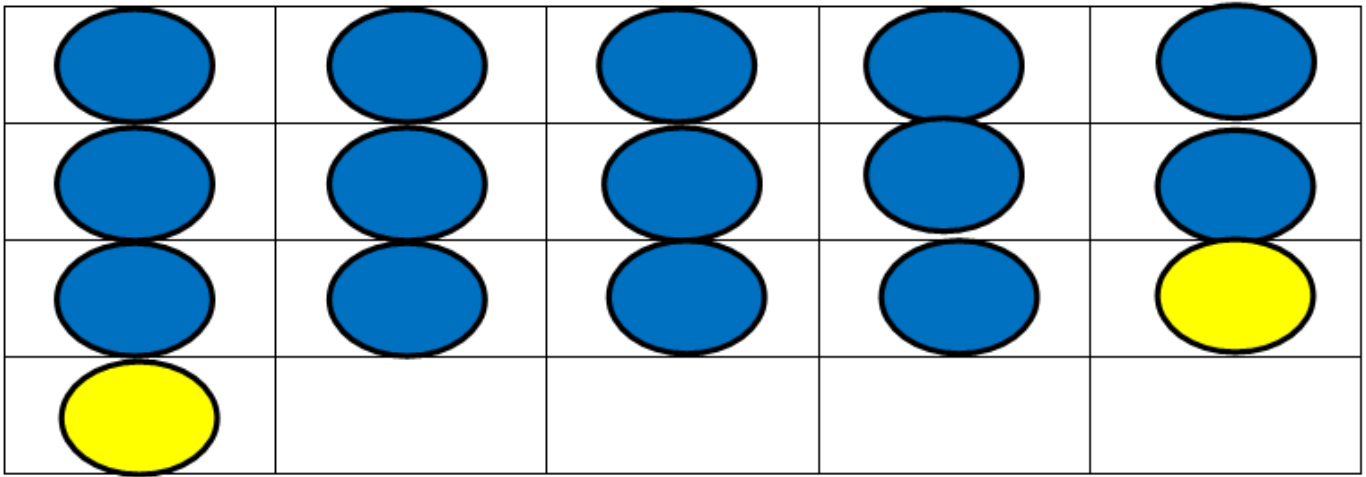
$$12 + 1 = 13$$

$$13 - 1 = 12$$

$$13 - 12 = 1$$

$$1 + 12 = 13$$

Try the questions below and see if you can see the related facts.

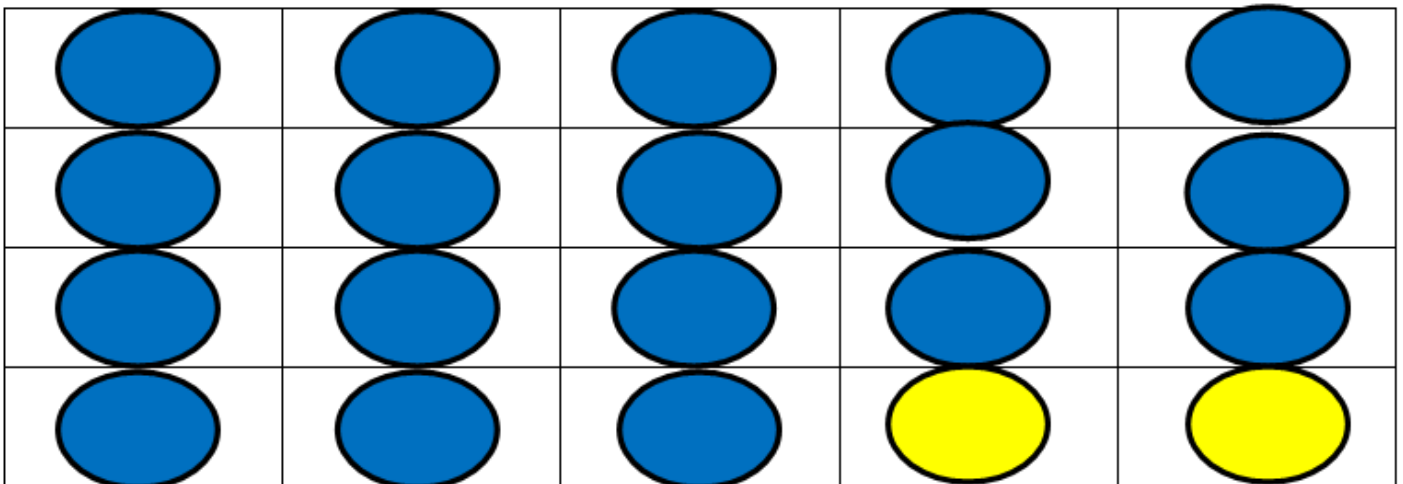


$$14 + 2 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$2 + 14 = \underline{\quad}$$

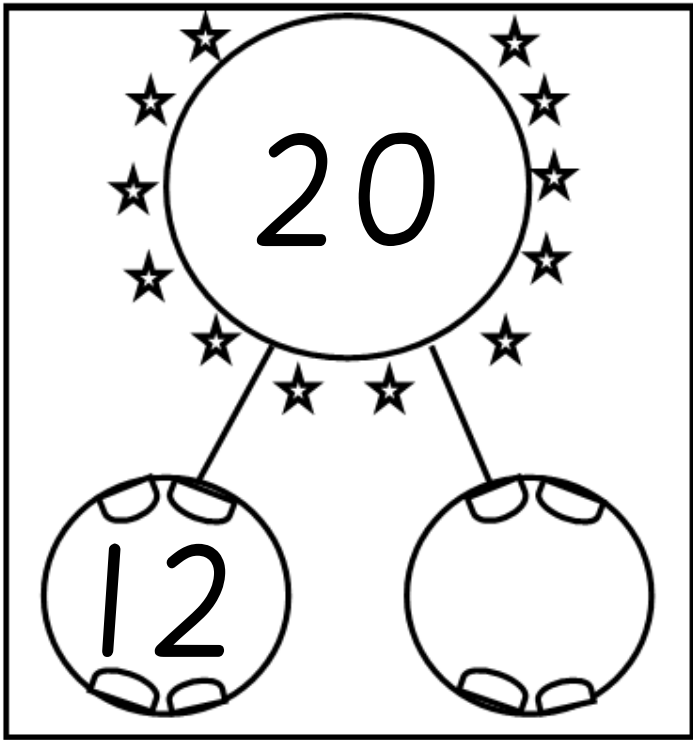


$$18 + 2 = \underline{\quad}$$
