Amphibian group

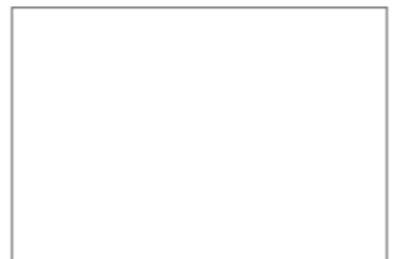
We start our lives in water, but can move on the land as adults.
