I can use my knowledge of adding 10 to add 9 and 11.

When adding 9 to a number, it is often quicker to add 10 and then take away 1.

Here is an example:

$$13 + 9 = 22$$

Working out

$$13 + 10 = 23$$

$$23 - 1 = 22$$

Have a go at the questions below. Use the box to write the calculations you do to work out the answer.

$$12 + 9 =$$

$$24 + 9 =$$

$$38 + 9 =$$

$$46 + 9 =$$

$$52 + 9 =$$

We can use a similar method when adding 11 to a number.

This time we add 10, then add another 1.

Here is an example:

$13 + 11 =$

Working out

$13 + 10 = 23$

$23 + 1 = 24$

$15 + 11 =$

$26 + 11 =$

$34 + 11 =$

$49 + 11 =$

$58 + 11 =$
