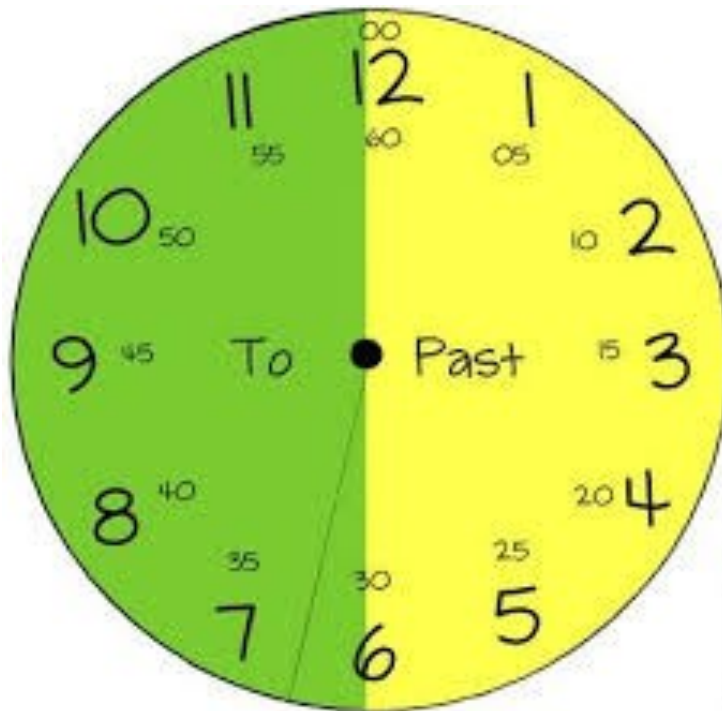

This clock shows us how long it takes for the hands to go around the clock. Starting at 12, it takes 60 to go around the clock. This means that it takes the second hand 60 seconds to go around the clock to make 1 minute. So we know that there are 60 seconds in a minute. That might not sound like a long time but get someone to time 60 second. It will feel much longer.

A fun game- A nice game you can play is everyone has to sit down together (one person much time 60 seconds) and when you think 60 seconds has gone by you stand up. Who ever is the closest wins.
