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I can plan my story

This week we have created our own creature, designed where it lives and figured out what it likes to eat. Now that we have all that amazing information, we are going to think about our own story based around The Bog Baby. Before we write our story, we are going to make a plan so what we have a really clear idea of the direction of our story.

Your story will need a Start, Middle and End.

Story Structure

Start- The start will include you going into the habitat where the creature lives (a wood, forest, pond, stream or the habitat that you chose). Try to think about what you can see around you, this is a great opportunity to describe what you can see, smell, touch or hear.

Middle- The middle is where you find the creature for the first time. What are they doing? How did you find them? And what do they look like? Be as descriptive as possible and tell me all about your creature.

End- The end, is when you decide to take the creature home. Try to think about where you would put it (in a bucket, outside pond, bath) and what it likes to eat.

We will be writing the story tomorrow, so just make a good plan with lots of ideas to help you write.
