



You are already experts at using interesting adjectives, you are going to be using this skill along with your interesting verbs and descriptive adverbs to write a 1st person recount of chapter 3.

You are going to imagine that you are sat on the hill when it starts to move. What happened? What did you think? What did you feel?

Don't forget to use your newly created adverbs (ending ly) and exciting verbs from your work this week.

Write in 1st person so this means you will be using the personal pronouns me, myself and I.

When you think you have finished writing, make sure you read through carefully...

- Have you got full stops and capital letters in the right place?
- Does it make sense and are there any missing words?
- Have you had your best go at spelling any tricky words (don't forget, if you're typing and a word appears with a red squiggly line underneath, the computer can suggest some words it thinks you mean!)?
- Have you got lots of descriptive language in there using verbs, adverbs, adjectives and (if you're feeling clever!) some fronted adverbials.
- Have you remembered to start a new line or leave a line in between your paragraphs?
- Have you got a really gripping, exciting opening (don't forget our work on this last week!)? Could you start with a question? Speech? Setting description?

If the answer is "no" to any of the above, go through your work so that it includes those things!!
