If you get stuck on a question, I would recommend counting in intervals (e.g. $35 \div 5$, count up in your 5s until you get to 35 and you've counted 7 times) or asking your self how many go into the big number (e.g. How many 5s go into 35, or something times 5 gives me 35).

You could always start with the ones you know best (e.g. 10s, 2s, 5s) to get you feeling more confident!
