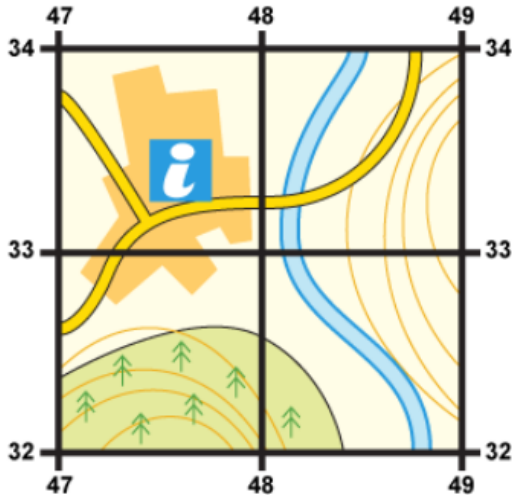


## Geography—4 figure grid references.

Watch the video first.

We need to remember two important things when creating our grid reference.

1) We are giving the grid reference of the **bottom left corner** of the square our 'place' is in.

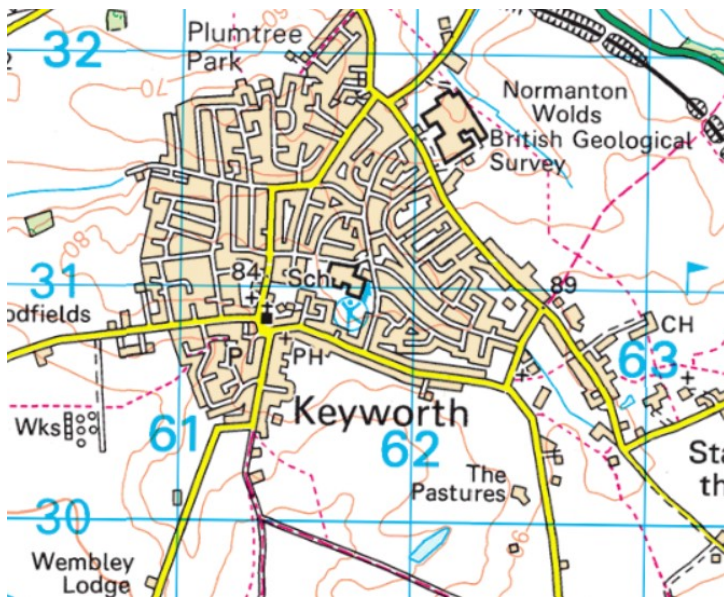


Here, if I wanted to tell someone where to find the Tourist Information office (the big blue 'i' symbol), I would be looking for the numbers relating to the bottom left corner..

2) We go **"along the corridor and up the stairs"** so we look along the bottom first (to find 47) left then looking up, along the side (to find 33).

So here our four figure grid reference is....4733

We're going to look now at an Ordnance Survey Map of Keyworth and the surrounding area....



If I was trying to find the 4 figure grid reference for Willow Brook.... I can see, going left to right, blue numbers (61,62,63). This is my **corridor**, going along.

I am looking for the **bottom left corner** of the square Willow Brook is in. So it is going to be 62.

Now **up the stairs**. I can see blue numbers going up (30,31,32). Again, looking for the bottom left corner of the square Willow Brook is in. So it is 30. So altogether my grid reference for Willow Brook is 3062.

The Geological Survey building would be in 6231.
