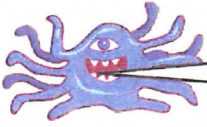


Proper nouns (1)



A proper noun names a particular person, place or thing. Proper nouns always start with a capital letter.

Example: city is a common noun but London is a proper noun.

London is the name of a particular or specific city.
