Perhaps a trip you all enjoyed when you were younger or something special that you do every year. Perhaps you can think of a really important event in your families history. Fill in the different sections of the sheet about when, where and how the event happened. Make sure to include a super picture.</p>	<p>Task 2- Maths</p> <p>Our learning objective: I can recognise tens and ones (to 50).</p> <p>Your task: Answer the questions by recognising and counting the tens and ones.</p>	<p>Task 3- Topic</p> <p>Our learning objective: I can discuss the importance of a library.</p> <p>Your task: Do libraries still have a place in the world today? Do you think libraries are important?</p> <p>Create a poster convincing people to visit a library.</p>

<p>Day 2 Tuesday</p>	<p>Task 1- English Our learning objective: I can write a short sentence.</p> <p>Your task: Write some short sentences about your event. Try to think about as much detail as you can. Try to remember how you felt during your event. Were you happy or sad, confused, or excited? Check the checklist on the sheet to see if you have included all your punctuation and information that you need. Use the example to help you.</p>	<p>Task 2- Maths Our objective: I can represent numbers to 50.</p> <p>Your task: In this task, numbers have been represented in a number of different ways. Find the tens and ones to help you identify the correct number which is being represented.</p>	<p>Task 3- PSHE Our objective: I can recognise a talent that I have.</p> <p>Your task: A talent is something that you are really good at. Ask your mum and dad, what are their talents? Then can you think what your talent is? Maybe you are a talented artist, maybe you are a talented writer.</p>

<p>Day 3 Wednesday</p>	<p>Task 1- English Our learning objective: I can write my event- Draft</p> <p>Your task: Write your family event in as much detail as you can. Use everything you have created so far to help you.</p>	<p>Task 2- Maths Our learning objective: I can compare objects (within 50).</p> <p>Your task: Compare the objects to identify which is greater and which is lesser. The numbers of objects are represented in different ways and an example has been done for you.</p>	<p>Task 3- Topic Our learning objective: Design your perfect library.</p> <p>Your task: What would be in your perfect library? Where would the books go? Do they sit on a shelf to nest like the books in <i>The Fantastic Flying Books</i>?</p>

<p>Day 4 Thursday</p>	<p>Task 1- English Our learning objective: I can publish my writing.</p> <p>Your task: Check over your draft from yesterday and then rewrite in neat. You can use the worksheet provided to write on and then illustrate to make it fantastic or you are welcome to be more creative and write it on another sheet to illustrate in your own way.</p> <p>Challenge- If you feel comfortable, it would be amazing if you would film yourself reading your family event.</p>	<p>Task 2- Maths Our objective: I can compare numbers (within 50).</p> <p>Your task: Compare the sets of numbers written on the task. Find which numbers are greater and which are lesser. You may want to use a number of different colouring pencils to help with comparing the numbers.</p>	<p>Task 3- Science Our objective: I can name an object and its material.</p> <p>Your task: Identify a variety of different objects and the materials they are made of. Think about why they have been made of that material and how it benefits the object.</p>

Day 5 Friday	<p>Task 1- Art</p> <p>Our learning objective: Introduction to Andy Goldsworthy.</p> <p>Your task: Andy Goldsworthy is a fantastic natural artist who works and lives in Scotland. He creates amazing pieces of art using natural materials found outside.</p> <p>I would like you to walk outside and have a go at your own Andy Goldsworthy inspired piece of natural art.</p>	<p>Task 2- My World</p> <p>Our objective: Your Half Term Highlight.</p> <p>Your task: Tell me all about your highlight from your half term break.</p> <p>Mine was enjoying a new book.</p>	<p>Task 3- Handwriting/Spelling</p> <p>Our objective: Handwriting practise- descenders- Letters that go below the line (j and g). Spelling- Alternative c and g sounds to go along with our live phonics learning this week.</p> <p>Your task: Practise your handwriting, ensuring the descenders go below the line (j and g). Remember that the capitals stay on the line and do not drop below.</p> <p>Spelling is practising alternative c like in city or ice and alternative g like gem or gentle.</p> <p>Challenge- Alphabet Letter Shapes. Look at the shapes on the sheet and then add the letters from underneath. Practise writing them to show which letters sit on the line, which letters ascend above the line and which descend below the line.</p>
