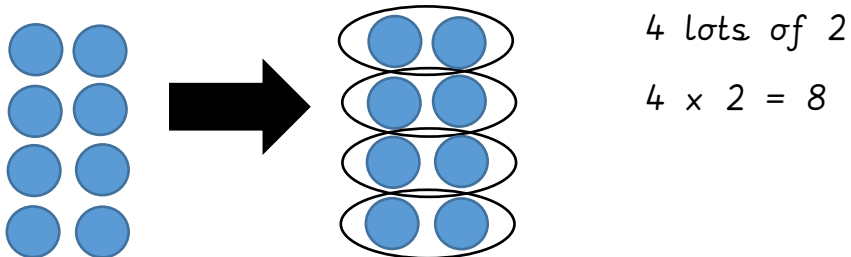

Arrays

Another way we can think about multiplication is by using an array.



Draw an array for each of these multiplications to work out the answer.

$3 \times 2 =$	$4 \times 5 =$	$2 \times 10 =$	$8 \times 2 =$
$1 \times 5 =$	$5 \times 2 =$	$4 \times 10 =$	$10 \times 5 =$
$3 \times 10 =$	$7 \times 2 =$	$4 \times 2 =$	$6 \times 2 =$
