STOP the video at 1:20. What do you notice about Morris' life from just this first part? How would you describe this character?

STOP the video at 4:30. at I've noticed something about the use of colour in the story. Why do you think Morris is in black and white and his surroundings are in colour?

Why do you think Morris' book has a hat and walking stick/cane on the front?

Why do you think Morris decides to follow the book?

STOP the video at 5:00. What do you think this building might be? Why do you think that?

STOP the video at 7:50. Why do you think the Humpty Dumpty book led Morris to the building full of books? (Think about what you have seen him do in the video)

How do we know this brown book is very old? (think about the music and how it behaves in the video)

STOP the video at 9:00. What is the Humpty Dumpty book telling Morris to do to bring the old brown book back to life?

STOP the video at 9:30. I would say that Morris gets lost in the book! What does "becoming lost in a book" mean in real life? How is that shown in the video?

STOP the video at 11:05. Why are some people in grey? Why do they change colour when Morris gives them a book?

STOP the video at 13:30. Where do you think Morris is going?

What do you think is inside the red book he leaves behind?
