What jobs do the adults in your lives have? Ask mums, dads, aunties, uncles, grandparents (perhaps exploring what they did before they retired if they are retired!), family friends, neighbours.

What sector do they work in? Sector means what category of work. It can sometimes be tricky to put jobs into a particular sector as there are so many jobs and some jobs might fit into more than one sector! You could use the different groups that I have suggested to the left but it's worth asking the adult what sector they would say they work in first. It's something that adults often get asked for all different reasons on a drop down list!!

Ask those adults what made them choose the job they are in?

Have they had more than one job in their life (maybe when they were in school/at university)? What made them change jobs? What might be the reason they changed jobs (ask them if you're able to)?
