

Today, you are going to write up your story of the autobiographical event from your life, using your story map from Tuesday and your speech paragraph from yesterday.

(children who are in the keyworker bubble at school during the week: I have inserted images of the work you have completed in class for you to refer back to)

When you think you have finished writing, make sure you read through your work carefully...

- Have you got full stops and capital letters in the right place? Have you remembered to only use one conjunction (and, because, but, or, if, so...) in each sentence?
- Does it make sense and are there any missing words?
- Have you had your best go at spelling any tricky words (don't forget, if you're typing and a word appears with a red squiggly line underneath, the computer can suggest some words it thinks you mean!)?
- Have you remembered to start a new line or leave a line in between your paragraphs (I would suggest a new paragraph for each section/box of your story map)?
- Have you used adjectives, interesting verbs (synonyms!), adverbs to really make your writing descriptive? Have you included the detail of what other people were doing? How they reacted to things? Any comments?
- When you've used any speech, have you remembered your speech punctuation? Refer back to my checklist from Tuesday! Remember, if there's no speech that gives the reader the impression that everything is happening in silence unless you've told them otherwise!

If the answer is "no" to any of the above, go through your work so that it includes those things!!
