

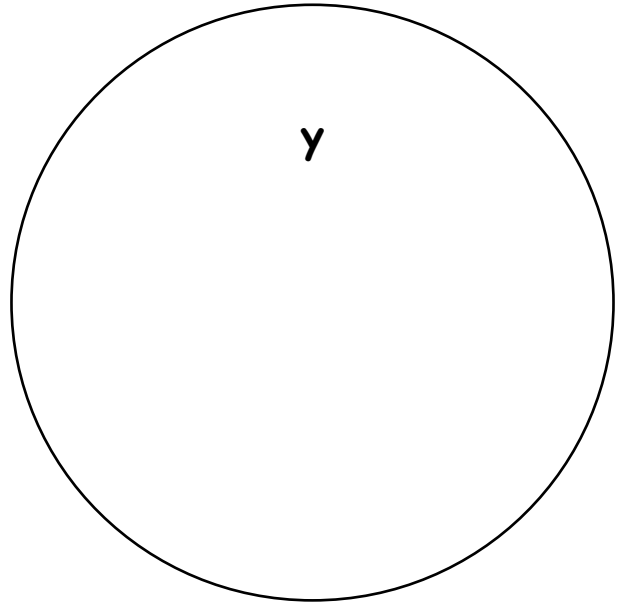
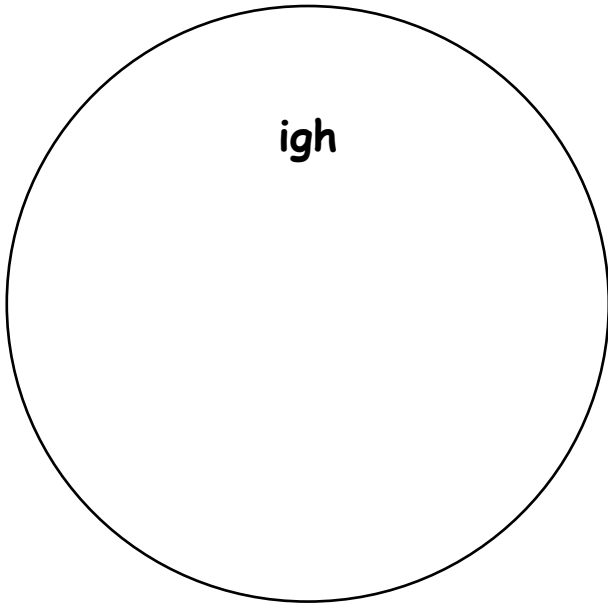

Spelling - the /igh/ sound spelt 'y'

Today we are looking at the 'igh' sound as in 'night' and 'sky' - these words both have the same sound in, but it is written in two different ways.

Task 1: Can you sort the words below into the right group?

Helpful hint! When the /igh/ sound is at the end of a word, it is most often spelt 'y'. There are some exceptions (high and sigh for example) - we just have to remember these!
