Keeping Safe

This half term in PSHE we are thinking about Keeping Safe. Today we are going to think about how to recognise situations that might not be safe, and rules that we follow to keep us safe.

Task 1: Talk to a grown up at home about the situations shown in the pictures. Do you think they are safe or not safe? If they are not safe, what action would you take to make them safe again? You don't need to write anything down for this task, just talk about it.



Task 2: Think about some rules that you follow that help keep you safe. Try to write down some rules for home, school and out and about - an example of each has been given. Are some of these rules 'age restrictions'? For example, it wouldn't be safe for you to drive a car, but a grown up who had learned to drive could.

Home	School	Out and about
Don't touch the oven.	Carry scissors pointing downwards.	Cross the road with a trusted adult.
