

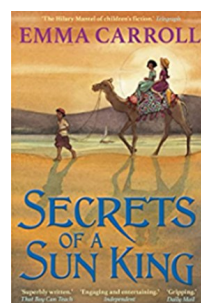
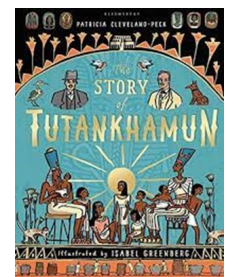
Class 3 Learning Letter Summer 2

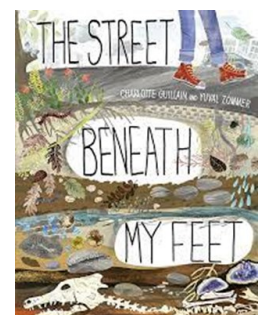


THE DIG
