Our spelling test will be on Thursday. There will be a big focus on multiplication and division this half term (3s, 4s, 8s in particular!) so any extra practise at home will be great. Watch out for useful websites to support with this at home in the children's homework books. With the colder weather drawing in, PE will be indoors as much as possible this half term. It will mostly be on a Monday, but please can children have their kit in school every day as this may change during this busy half term.
