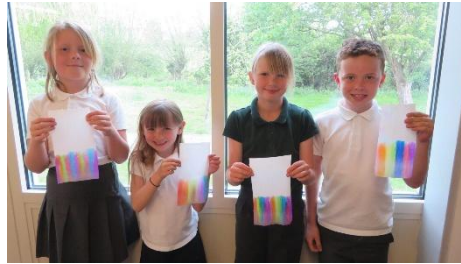


Class 3 Learning Letter
