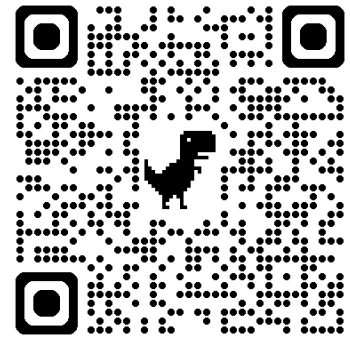


Year 1 Learning Letter
